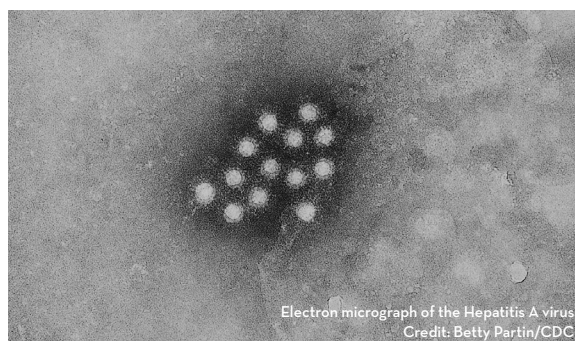


HEPATITIS A:
