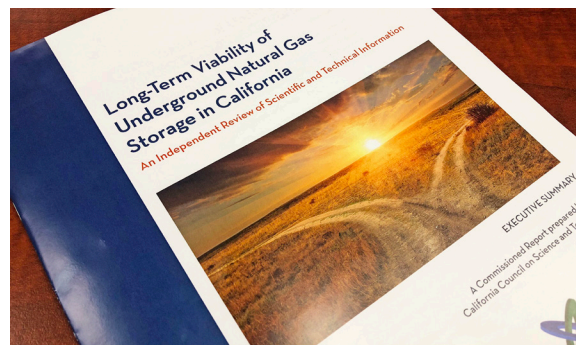


UNDERGROUND NATURAL GAS STORAGE: A CCST EXPERT BRIEFING
