The issue that really jumps out at me is, if I am reading this correctly, the report has a graph which compares smart meters with other technologies and assumed the smart meter is constantly on. This is ridiculous and misleading since it might be on for a few minutes – total – per day. Consequently it appears to me that the exposure comparison on page 5 is not accurate and if based on the actual amount of time that the meter is transmitting (once every 4 hours) or even future levels (once every 15 minutes) would show that the exposure level would be practically immeasurable. Am I misreading this?
